# ***Superglide***

*Residential Stairlift*

The Superglide has evolved over time to make it one of the most technologically advanced stairlifts in the world.

The Superglide is powered by a maintenance-free DC power pack, which ensures your lift will still work in the event of a power failure.

### **REMOTE CONTROL**

The hand held remote "calls" the lift to where you need it.



The Superglide's smooth-start and smooth-stop action means just that! No sudden jerks or stops.

### **SWIVEL SEAT**

At the top landing, the chair turns to allow the rider to exit and enter the seat at a safe distance away from the steps.



### **DIAGNOSTIC DIGITAL DISPLAY**

The on-board diagnostic control panel alerts you to any potential problems before they arise.

### **SAFETY SURFACES**

Safety sensors detect possible obstructions and will immediately stop the Superglide.



*The Superglide is powered by direct current (DC), supplied by rechargeable batteries, which deliver a smooth, ultra-quiet and safe ride. You'll have a feeling of safety and stability when using the Superglide.*

### **SEAT BELTS**

The stairlift can be fitted with either an inertia reel lap harness or a static type, 3 point fixing, over-shoulder harness.



The fold-up seat and footrest make the lift only 12" wide so that it sits 14.5" from the wall.

The Superglide gives the smoothest, quietest and most luxurious ride quality currently available.

### **OPTIONAL BRIDGING PLATFORM**

The bridging platform can offer a quick, cost effective solution to certain types of curved staircase. Good examples are winding turns right at the top of the stairs, or perhaps a turn on a flat landing where there are 2 or 3 steps after the turn.



### **OPTIONAL HINGED RAIL**

The lower section of the rail folds up and out of the way when not in use, allowing greater access at the foot of the stairs. A good example of the application of a hinged rail is when there is a doorway at or near the foot of the stairs, and where a fixed rail would obstruct the doorway.
