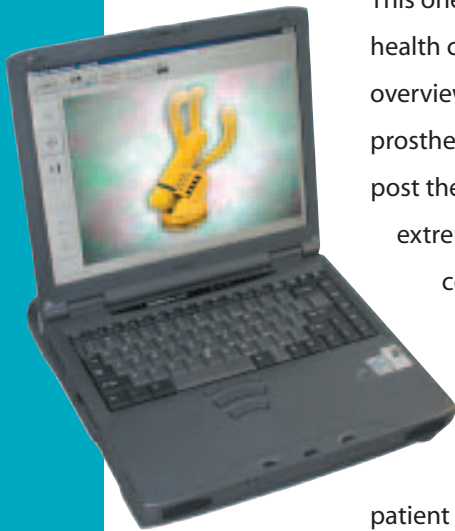

Upper Extremity Limb Loss Rehabilitation: An Introductory Course for Therapists



This one-day course provides health care professionals with an overview of amputation levels, prosthetic options and pre and post therapy ideas for the upper extremity limb loss patient. The course also discusses the role of the prosthetist and how therapists and prosthetists work together to improve patient outcome. Additional topics

include an overview of myoelectric technology which uses the muscle signals from the residual limb to open and close the prosthetic hand or greifer. Health care professionals will also have hands-on lab practice using computer evaluation tools and prosthetic components.

This course is a prerequisite to an advanced 2-day course for therapists on upper extremity prosthetic education and functional training.
