

Competitive Bid Program WRIGHT&FILIPPIS®

Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has awarded the competitive bidding contracts for Spinal bracing to Wright & Filippis for the Flint & Lapeer areas.

Medicare's Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) Competitive Bidding Program changes the amount Medicare pays for certain DMEPOS. Under this program, suppliers submit bids to provide certain items and supplies to people with Medicare living in, or visiting, competitive bidding areas. Medicare uses these bids to set the amount it pays for each item. All suppliers are thoroughly screened to make sure they meet Medicare requirements (such as eligibility and financial, quality, and accreditation standards) before they are awarded contracts.

You are affected by the Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) Competitive Bidding Program if you live in (or are visiting) certain areas of the country and need an off-the-shelf back or knee brace. Below are the eligible regions in Michigan.

LSO

Universal sized LSO with lateral control offers 5:1 compression and stabilization to fit most patients with one brace. For post-operative stabilization management protocol following spinal fusion, laminectomy/laminotomy, foraminotomy, laproscopic disc replacement, IDET procedures and multilevel decompression.





TLSO

TLSO offers superior compression and stabilization from T2 to S1. An adjunct to pre- and postoperative procedures, for acute pain relief by thoracic postural extension alignment, early onset through variable stages of osteoporosis, compression fractures of the thoracic spine, kyphosis, and thoracic mechanical back pain.

LSO

Elastic LSO offers support and compression from L1 to S1. For post-operative stabilization management protocol following spinal fusion, laminectomy/laminotomy, foraminotomy, laproscopic disc replacement, IDET procedures and multi-level decompression.





Lumbosacral

This Men's Clinch-It Lumbosacral Support is used for lower back support. It uses a two-pull side lace adjustment technique for achieving the perfect fit. This brace also uses cinch-pull adjustable straps for front closure, which is great for people with arthritic hands. The many features of this brace include: elastic releases at the top and groin to ensure comfort and mobility. One pair of preshaped twelve inch steels and flexible stays for the front, back and sides are also included.
